

Membership

Annual membership dues for Daifukujiki Soto Mission are \$60.00 a year per household. Allowance is made for those who cannot afford the full membership fee.

Privileges of membership include:

- * Receiving the Precepts & one's Buddhist name in a Soto Zen Buddhist Lay Confirmation Ceremony
- * Use of social hall for private functions at a \$300.00 donation, plus a refundable \$200.00 cleaning deposit.**
- * Reservation of a niche in the columbarium at a one-time donation of \$500.00 for the privilege of using the niche space. **
- * Participation in Project Dana, a monthly kupuna activity program which is provided free for temple seniors.
- * Use of the temple's lending library.
- * Monthly newsletter

**Members become eligible for use of social hall and columbarium after two years of consecutive membership. A membership application may be submitted for each household. However, adult household members may submit separate applications if they so choose. If membership fees are not received for 2 consecutive years, the membership will be considered resigned or inactive.
